- Crypt. IT \$5 med. 7.50 blooming size
- Fasc. pitcairni " " "
- gr. X 'Magnifica' var. striata \$10 med. only, but striations vary
- " Sanguinea var. erecta 7.50 med. only
- VR. polonia 7.50 med. only

Out of stock on the others, the response was tremendous & we hate to get too low, so will keep the remainder & check with us by fall to see if there are sufficient to sell. The varieties you listed will be gone shortly, so suggest you order as soon as possible.
