TILLANDSIA SPECIES

brachycaulos - From Pexico and Central America.

This still gray icaves are about \$" wide and 6" to "" long. The entire plant turns red and has purple flowers. This makes a most spectacular plant growing on a tree, drifty wood, or tree ferm.

bulbosa - Prom fexico. This plant is more like a swollen bulb. Leaves are green and curled, roiled up at tips, which turn red at flower-'g time. Tubular flowers are purple. An "tractive and unusual plant. Does very well wounted on tree fern slabs.

ionantna - This small plant from hexico is a beautiful sight when it starts to flower. It's silver-gray leaves turn a vivid red when grown in bright light. Plowers are purple. (The can also be sounted on driftwood or cork bark.)

junceo - The leaves of this broweliad are rather fine and grass-like. At flowering time a siem of red bracts arises from the leaves bearing purple flowers. Very good wounted. Does well on a tree in mild climate.

kacwinskyana - A silver-gray rosette. Dainty plant which multiplies fast. The lax blooming spike has flowers with glossy green sepals and lilac petals.
